# STOP THE SILENCE

**Domestic and family violence is abusive behavior by one person to control and dominate another person within a close relationship. It may include physical assault, psychological abuse, social abuse, economic abuse or emotional abuse.**

The damaging effects of violence are profound. There are studies that indicate children raised in violent homes are likely to repeat such acts as adults leading to a destructive pattern often referred to as “the cycle of abuse.”

This pamphlet provides information and resources to assist in finding a safe way out of an abusive environment.
