LABOR TRAFFICKING AND THE INTERSECTION WITH DOMESTIC VIOLENCE AND SEXUAL ASSAULT

Overview of labor trafficking, explores the intersection with domestic violence and sexual assault, and identifies protections and services available to survivors of labor trafficking

HUMAN TRAFFICKING IN DOMESTIC SERVITUDE

Defining domestic servitude, identifying factors that make domestic workers vulnerable to exploitation, and the distinctions between labor exploitation and human trafficking

HUMAN TRAFFICKING IN AGRICULTURAL LABOR

Identifying migrant and seasonal worker vulnerabilities that make them susceptible to exploitation.

TEMPORARY VISA PROGRAMS AND THE RISK OF HUMAN TRAFFICKING

Overview of how temporary Visa programs in the US make certain populations vulnerable to human trafficking, red flags indicating vulnerable populations, and available resources.

ENGAGING CHILD VICTIMS OF SEX TRAFFICKING: THE ROLE OF THE CHILD WELFARE WORKER

Training whose goal is to enhance victim response by equipping child welfare professionals with necessary knowledge & skills, and ensure victims receive comprehensive, trauma-informed care through the targeting of existing service and resource gaps.

ADDRESSING TRAFFICKING IN SCHOOLS
